Olivia got messages from Mrs. Kato every day. When she didn't understand some words, she used a dictionary. She tried studying Japanese every free moment, even when she had just a little time. When she came home, she talked about that day's *bento* with Mrs. Kato. Her Japanese \*gradually got better, and she started to enjoy speaking Japanese. She thought, "Mrs. Kato makes a *bento* for me every day and helps me learn Japanese. I hope I can do the same thing for her someday."

Do you have any dogs or cats? Today, many people have them as pets. A \*survey shows that about 6,000,000 dogs are \*registered in Japan. Many people think that dogs and cats are important members of their \_\_\_\_\_\_\_. The pet \*industry has developed, and people spend a lot of money on \*products and services for pets.

On the other hand, there are many poor dogs and cats that die. From April 2020 to March 2021, about 72,000 dogs and cats were \*abandoned and about one-third of them died in \*shelters. There are some dogs and cats that are used for \*experiments. It may be necessary for us human to use animals to develop medicine and new \*technologies but, at the same time, some of them \*suffer and even die because of these experiments.

Why do people abandon their pets? There are many reasons. Some people say that they are moving and they can't have pets at their new home. Some \*elderly people can't keep their pets because of \*physical limitations. Also, when their dogs and cats become sick and old, people sometimes abandon them.

But are <u>(a) these</u> good reasons to abandon such an important member of their <u>あ</u>?

The government has made a new animal \*law to protect these pets. Also, there are many people who have been trying to find new homes for abandoned dogs and cats. However, the most important thing is to \*prevent people from abandoning their pets in the first place.

These days, there are many pet shops around us. We can see many cute dogs and cats. Some buy a dog or cat without \*considering seriously. However, before buying a pet, people need to consider many things. For example, "Can we keep a cat in our \*apartment?" "Do all the members of our family agree to live with an animal?" "Do we have enough time and money to take care of a dog?" "What will we do when the dog becomes sick and old?" and so on. Having a pet puts their lives in your hands. We should never forget that.
